Description	
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>	
<p>On November 27, 2024, at the School Complex in Sławatycze, we conducted participatory memory workshops around the burial site of a Jewish woman buried in Krzywówólka. A Jewish woman called Binefowa, the wife of a miller, a resident of Krzywówólka, was hiding in Krzywówólka. She was murdered by the Ukrainian police in 1942 and buried in the animal cemetery in Krzywówólka. Until now, her burial site had remained invisible.</p> <p>Through joint action involving the local community, the youth of the School Complex in</p>	

Sławatycze, the burial site was marked with a wooden matzeva.

During the workshops, together with students from one grade of primary school, we prepared a wooden marker in the form of a matzeva, and then - using a portable laser - we burned an inscription and symbols on it.

After the workshops, together with the youth, we went to the burial site of the Jewish woman Binefowa, where a ceremony was held to commemorate the site with a wooden matzeva. Paweł Jowik, a resident of Krzywówólka and a graduate of the school in Sławatycze, participated in the workshops, from whom we learned about this place. He told the students about this place and about his interest in the history of the town and its surroundings.

The event was preceded by field research conducted by the foundation team. They met with the residents of Krzywówólka who remembered this story or knew it from stories.
